Ralph Reichert brings more than 35 years of law enforcement experience, specializing in special events, and personal, facility, and infrastructure security planning and operations. He was the first Terrorism Division Director for the State of Georgia following the attacks of September 2001. Under his direction, this division developed and implemented programs regarding intelligence collection and dissemination, critical infrastructure protection, crisis and consequence management, special events planning and operations, and capability enhancements for first response disciplines throughout the state. He responded to numerous real or suspected terrorist incidents and natural disasters, initiated Incident Command System procedures, and coordinated response assets and resources.

He was involved in command positions for numerous special events, emergencies and disasters. He served as the Consequence Management Section Director in the FBI's Joint Operations Center for the G8 Summit, served as the Homeland Security Coordinator for the state's Counter Terrorism Task Force, and planned, collaborated and coordinated with various law enforcement special operations teams to include SWAT, Bomb and Mobile Field Force teams. He served on numerous Department of Homeland Security advisory groups, and participated as a subject matter expert in federal and national terrorism response exercises.

Ralph was awarded a Bachelor of Science Degree from Southern Illinois University and a Master of Public Administration Degree from Kennesaw State University. He enlisted in the United States Army and was awarded a Bronze Star during service in Viet Nam.
